mug cake

Serves: 1

Ingredients

- 4 tablespoons plain flour
- 2 1/2 tablespoons unsweetened cocoa powder
- 4 tablespoons sugar
- 1/2 tablespoons baking powder
- 7 tablespoons Coca Cola

Method:

Mix all ingredients together into an over-sized mug. This cake rises a lot so if you don't have a very large mug, I suggest you split the mixture into two mugs after mixing. Mix with a small whisk until no lumps remain.

For one oversized mug, microwave for 1 1/2 minutes. The cake should have a dry surface and the knife inserted should come out clean. You may want to reduce the time for two smaller mugs.

Tip--This cake rises a lot so watch out.

SCIENCE EXHIBITION

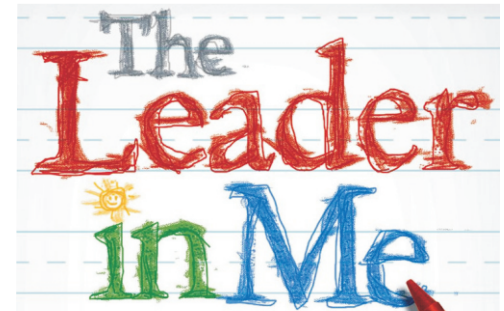

WE REMEMBER ARHAM HUSSAIN

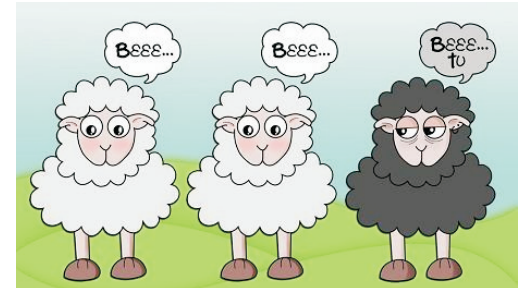
Our student of Class VIII C who suddenly passed away on 04.07.14.
